Summer Sport vs DHS

With all the cricket and outdoor basketball games being cancelled on Saturday due to the rain, the only contested fixtures between St Charles College and Durban High School were indoors. The basketball results in order of play were as follows: U14A - SCC won 40-14, U15A - SCC won 22-21, 3rd team - SCC won 36-16, 2nd team - SCC won 32-26 and the 1st team - DHS won 57-52. Darren Holcomb, head coach of the Saints, reported on the game:

St Charles College and DHS took to the court for the third time this season on Saturday having already played each other twice during the Spring League. The first two meetings had been shared with DHS winning the first game narrowly and the Saints claiming the win in the Spring League semi-final. The third instalment of this fixture was a tightly fought affair.

DHS dominated the first period with pressure defence which led to easy fast break points and ultimately resulted in an early 10 point lead. The Saints, playing at home, fought back in the second period reducing the lead to just a point at the half. With both teams playing good basketball, the score throughout the second half was close with DHS holding a slight edge in the second half. The Saints, under time pressure were forced to foul in the closing minutes, but DHS was up to the task and managed to convert on some important free throws.

The Saints now take on Maritzburg College in the much anticipated Friday night fixture.

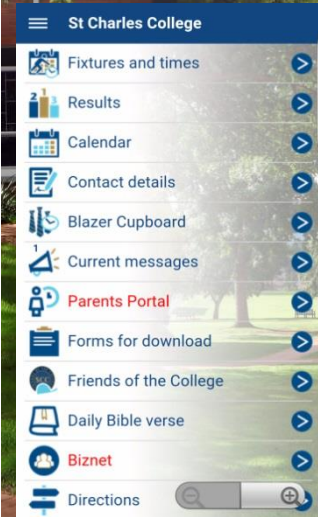
