

THE FOUNDER'S History DAY DASH...



St Charles College was founded on 26 July 1875. To celebrate this the College instituted a Founder's Day Dash on 26 July 2012 when the whole College from Grade 000 to A levels lined the jacaranda avenue and contenders vied for immortality by achieving the best time in a run from the gates, around the first circle and back. Every year there are 3 races: the Prep, the Middle School and the Upper School. Competitors race in their house colours and the bell in the memorial garden next to the Coach House is used to start the races. Ringing the bell is an honour given to incredible members of staff who have served our College with distinction for more than a quarter of a century. Previous bell ringers include retirees, Mrs Ann Botha (34 years of service) and Mrs Grace Mhlongo (29 years of service); while current staff members include Mrs Barbara Thorpe and

Mrs Janet de Croes (25 years of service), Mrs Isabelle Matten, Mr Graham Stewart-Burger and Mr Stewart Bradford (all 26 years of service).

The distance is awkward at 540m, but the reward is great. The winner each year has his name and the time etched onto a brass plaque on a water fountain donated by the Matrics of 2012. Mason O'Connor, the first winner of *The Dash*, holds the current record with a time of 1:16.97.

While the 2020 edition of *The Dash* has necessarily been postponed, we look forward to the tradition continuing as soon as it is safe to do so. – Mr Rowan Irons (Director of Sport)





wonderful school."



their scientific reasoning skills. The practicals are an important component of the chemistry syllabus and bring the theory learnt in a lesson to life.




