## WHAT DID YOU WANT TO BE WHEN YOU WERE SMALL?

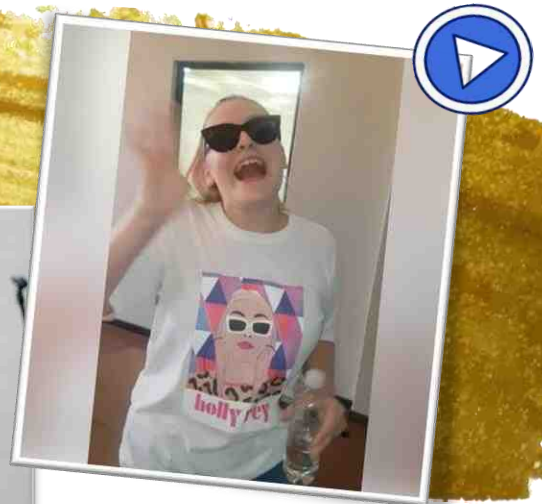
When I was younger, I always wanted to be a fireman because I liked the fire trucks. Then I realized that there was more to the job than sliding down poles and playing in the foam.

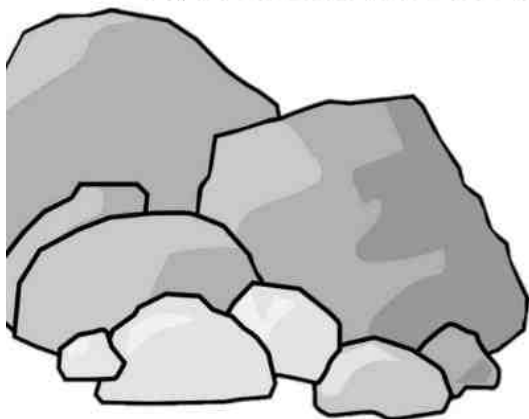
