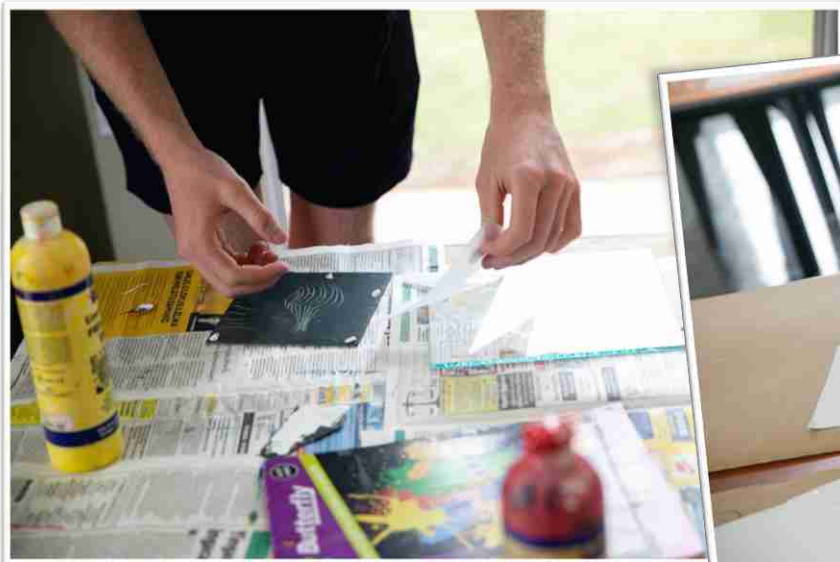
MUSIC DEPARTMENT *Revamp*

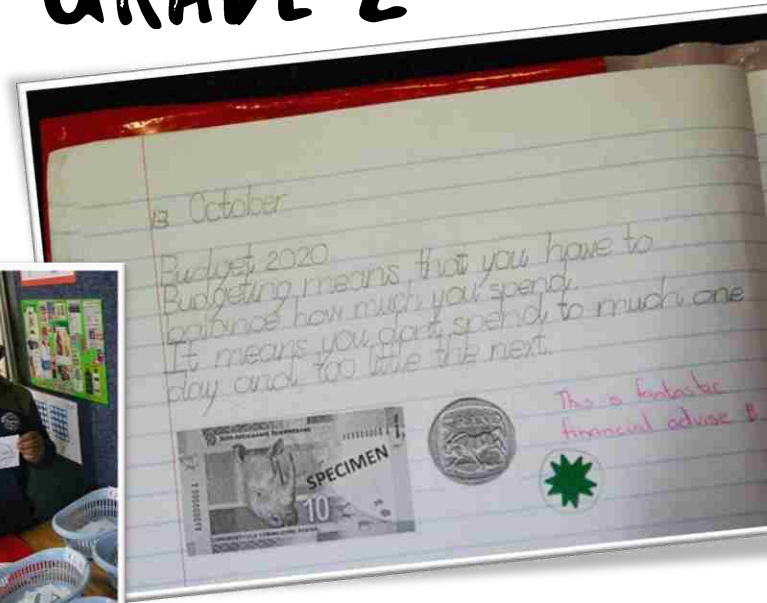
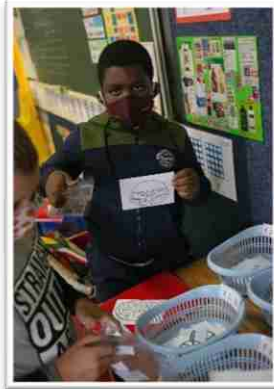
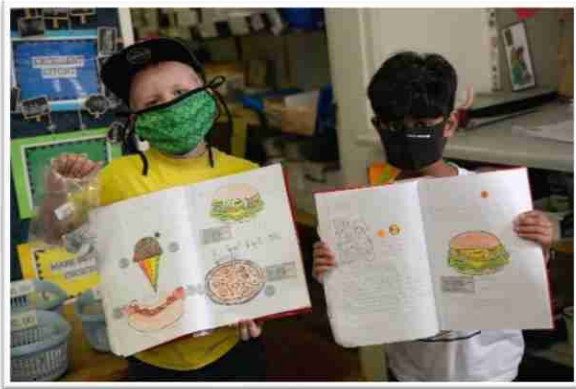
GRADE 1 Art

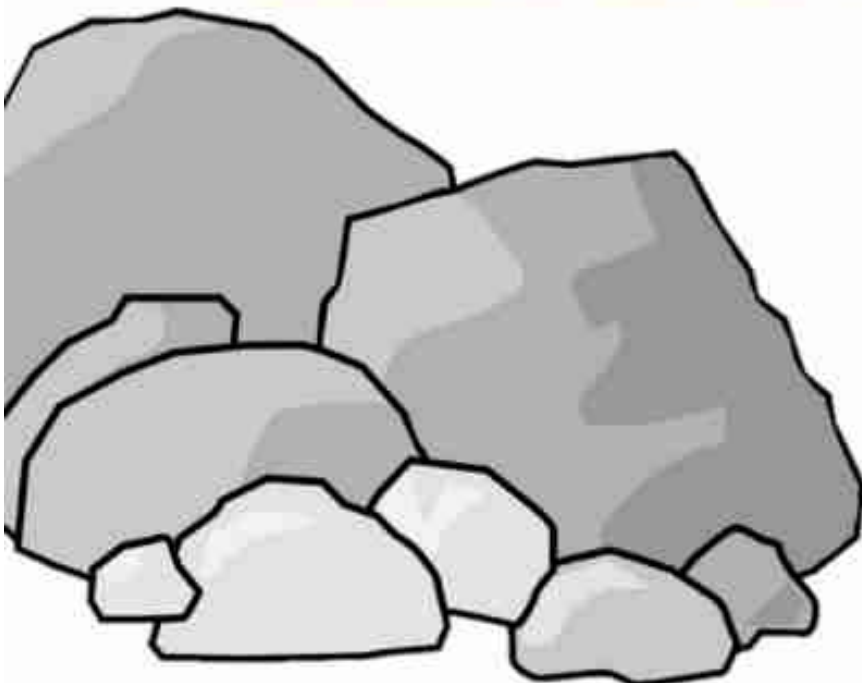
