

## Saints TRACK AND FIELD



# Friends of Bisley BRIDGE BUILDING PROJECT



and tennis courts, all the way to the music room.




# SENIOR SCHOOL Artwork


## Grade 3 Creative Writing

- Top-up Walker!**  
 Deposit funds into your TapTuck Walker with EFT or Credit Card. There is a R2 transaction fee charged.
- Add a Kid!**  
 Add a picture so we can identify your child. Set name, grade, class & dietary information. Scan your child's TapTuck card purchased at the back shop. Set pocket money spend limits for each kids card.
- Order Ahead!**  
 Order your healthy meal for breakfast time & skip the queues!

### Frequently Asked Questions

- Where do I get my TapTuck card from?**  
 Cards can be purchased at the back shop from the back shop convenor or they can be purchased in app and your kid can collect at the backshop. Once you have the card, scan the card in your kid in app.
- Does my kid need the card to buy at the tuck shop?**  
 Yes, the back shop convenor will scan the card with every purchase. You can set daily and weekly spend limits on each kids card.
- What do I do if I have lost my card?**  
 Purchase a new card at the back shop and simply re-scan in app.
