

SAINTS DEBATING News

On Thursday, 18 August, the St Charles College Grade 8 and Junior Debating Teams competed in the Semi-Finals of the Pietermaritzburg Debating League (PMBDL) against GHS and Epworth respectively. The Grade 8 motion dealt with whether Artificial Intelligent toys that are able to hold conversations are justified and the Juniors debated about whether space exploration is regrettable.

Cian Jacobs, Zach Bormann and Kadyn Maharaj, all in Grade 8, are a talented team of boys and looked strong going into the debate. This was a challenging round for them as it was the first time that they were required to prepare both sides of the motion. Drawing Opposition, the team debated well but after a lengthy adjudicator deliberation, lost to a strong GHS team.

The Junior debating team also debated on Thursday and were matched against a traditionally strong Epworth side. The boys were challenged to their limits as they only had one hour to prepare their arguments for the Semi-Final round. Following a 35-minute deliberation by the adjudicators, St Charles College were awarded the victory with Zahid Khan (Grade 9) being awarded the Best Speaker of the debate. The Junior team will debate online in the Finals of the PMBDL against TWC on 25 August at 3pm, with the debate starting at 4pm. Virtual spectators will be welcome! Zahid Khan and Raahil Ramklown (Grade 9) have also been selected as part of the Pietermaritzburg Debating Squad that is to compete at the Junior KZN Debating Championships from 3 – 5 September. Cian Jacobs has been selected as a trialist for the PMB Squad and will undergo his trial on Thursday, 19 August. The tournament itself is intellectually intensive as the boys compete in at least five debates across three days.


