

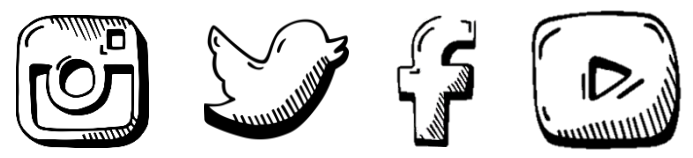

# Saints SUMMER SPORT

## SAINTS BASKETBALL – 1<sup>ST</sup> TEAM VS MICHAELHOUSE

St Charles College hosted their first basketball game on campus since the lockdown restrictions were enforced in early 2020 and, even though spectators were still not permitted, it was great to have basketball back on campus. Although the standard of basketball, after the long absence, was not great from either team, both sides played with determination and a will to win.

With a large part of the scoring coming from the foul line, the game was predictably close; however, it was Michaelhouse who opened a 9-point lead heading into the fourth quarter. Behind their solid zone defence and rebounding ability, Michaelhouse restricted the Saints' opportunities and allowed them to transition with some easy, uncontested lay-ups.



With only 10 minutes left in the game, SCC implemented a full court press which resulted in some turnovers and easy baskets for the home team. With Michaelhouse holding a 1-point lead with 9 seconds on the clock, SCC had the opportunity to steal the game; however, it was not to be as 'House' held on for the away win. ## SAINTS CRICKET – 1<sup>ST</sup> TEAM VS MICHAELHOUSE

After winning an important toss, Michaelhouse set out to bat on what must be one of the best wickets in the province.

They got off to rollicking start and were too strong in the morning for our young bowling attack, amassing a total of 285 off their allotted 50 overs. St Charles College in reply were magnanimous.

After a fine start by debutant, Daniel Wassenaar, 65 off 98 balls, which set the tone for our strong middle order to see us to the end, Ntando Zuma batted as well as he has ever done in his short career, scoring his first century on the SCG – 114 off 123 balls. He was aptly supported by Hayden Raw, 20 off 14 balls, and Sam Brown, 30 off 21 balls. However, after an excellent chase, and some brilliant batting in reply, the Saints fell just short by 21 runs scoring 261/7 off their 50 overs. Some untimely run outs at the end proving their demise.

Overall, the picturesque oval was the scene for a brilliant game of schoolboy cricket, where over 500 runs were scored.

After a load-shedding affected mid-week game at Eston against Westville, we now look forward to welcoming Maritzburg College 1<sup>st</sup> XI (and spectators) to The Oval on Saturday.

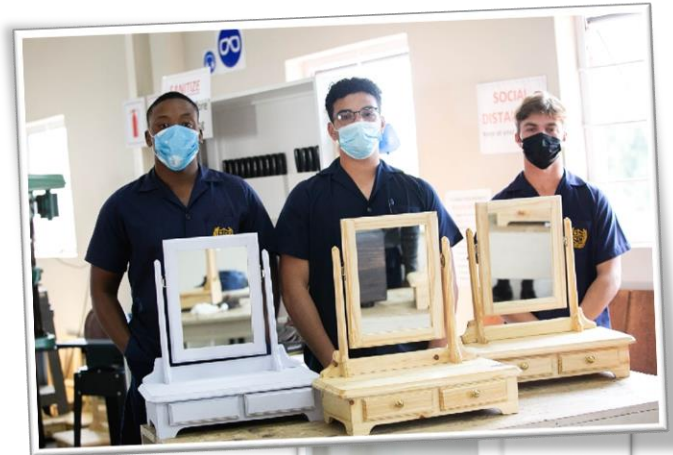




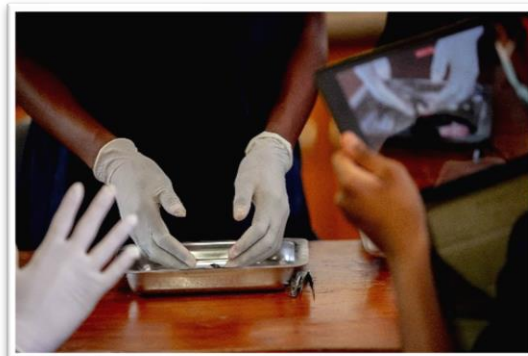
# GRADE 11 Woodwork PROJECT

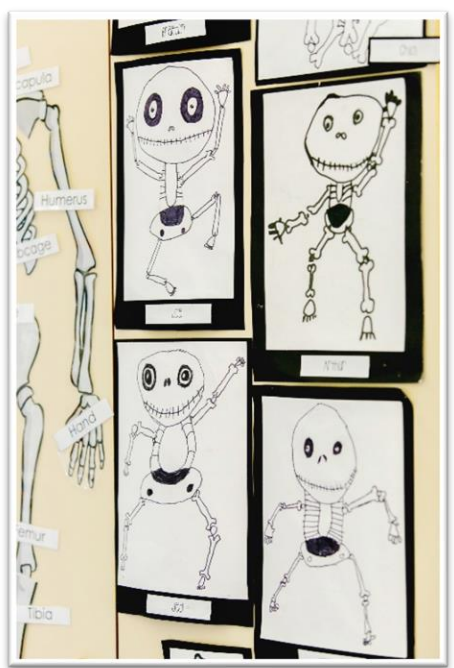


## ART AFTERNOONS IN THE Senior Primary

Our Grade 4 and 5 boys were proud to have their art up on display this week in the Senior Primary.

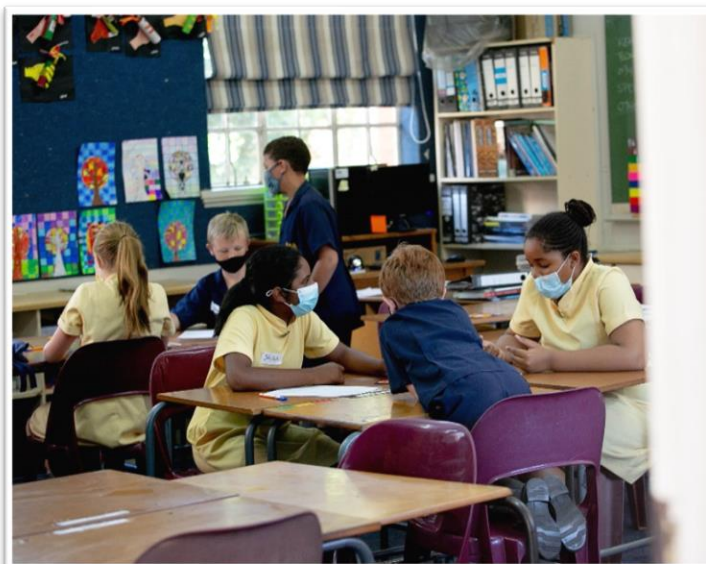






# GRADE 4 AND 5 Maths Morning

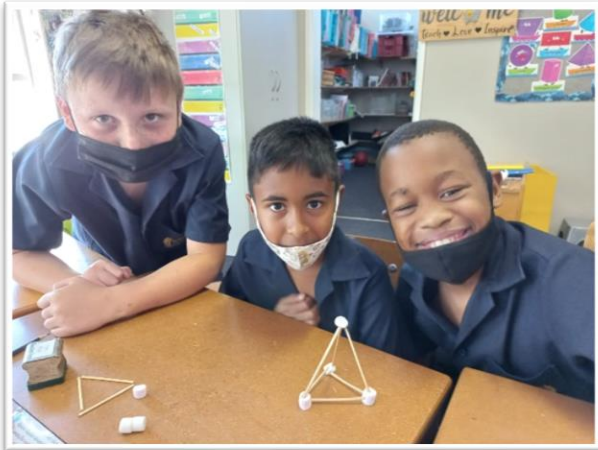
Earlier this week our Grade 4 and 5 boys were excited to welcome the girls from St John's D.S.G. onto campus for a morning of Maths and problem-solving.
